## SPECIAL DEPARTMENT RULES:

- A. Exhibitors may enter one item per class. NO article can be entered for competition more than one year. Items must be new (made between September 2012 and August 2013), clean and of quality craftsmanship.
- B. All articles entered shall be under the control of the Superintendent of this department.
- C. Awards will be made according to the merits of the exhibit. If no competition exists or if an article is not worthy of 1st premium, the judge may disqualify or award 2nd, 3rd or 4th premiums at his or her discretion. Where no competition exists but the judge deems the item worthy of a blue ribbon it can be considered for Grand Champion.
- D. The EISF will not be responsible in any way for security of entries, but precautions will be taken to protect against breakage, theft, or damage of any kind.
- E. Professional is defined as any person who has acquired a State Sale Tax number and/or has advertised his or her crafts in any form of mass communication media and/or received extensive formal training in their craft.
- F. A person may not enter both amateur and professional in the same class.

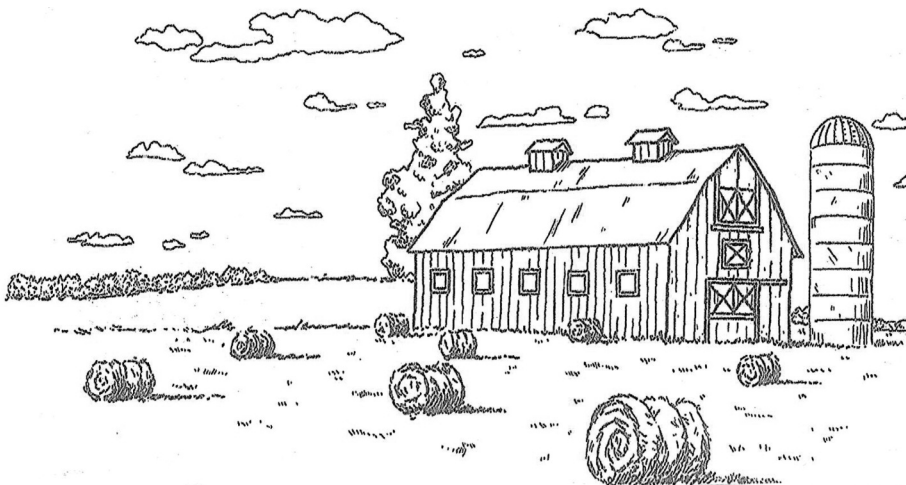
