- D. Judging will commence promptly at 2:00 p.m. on Friday in Hobbies & Craft Building.

**ENTRY FEE:**

- A. \$1.00 EACH FOR THE FIRST 4 ENTRIES OR \$5.00 PER SHEET WILL BE CHARGED TO ALL EXHIBITORS.

**PREMIUMS:**

- A. Monday - Saturday, September 3-8, from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
- B. Sunday, September 9 from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
- C. After September 9 awards will be given out only during regular office hours. Premiums not claimed by September 30 will be considered a donation and will revert back to the Fair's general fund.

**SPECIAL DEPARTMENT RULES:**

- A. Flowers will be judged on quality of blossom, foliage, arrangement and stem. NO ARTIFICIAL FLOWERS WILL BE ALLOWED. Only flowers from the home garden are eligible.
- B. Only one entry accepted in each class from any one exhibitor. ONLY ONE VARIETY OF FLOWER CAN BE ENTERED IN ANY ONE CLASS. ANY DUPLICATE ENTRIES WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.
- C. When using your own containers, be sure to place a red sticker (provided) on front of entry tag. A limited number of containers are available for your use.
- D. The Supervisor shall have the right to remove at any time any exhibits or parts thereof which are unsightly.
- E. Exhibits will be released on Sunday, after the Fair, between 10:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. If absolutely necessary some exhibits may be picked up after 9:00 p.m. Saturday. Security will be provided Saturday evening. The E.I.S.F. will not be responsible for exhibits left after Sunday at 3:00 p.m.
- F. IF ENTERING A NAMED ROSE OR OTHER FLOWER, PLEASE SPECIFY NAME ON BACK OF ENTRY TAG. IF ENOUGH OF A SPECIFIC VARIETY IS ENTERED THEY WILL BE JUDGED IN THEIR OWN CATEGORY. If entering a flower variety not listed, specify the name on the entry tag. If there are 3 entries in a specific category a new class will be added. If there are 3 or more entries of a specific color, a separate class will be added.

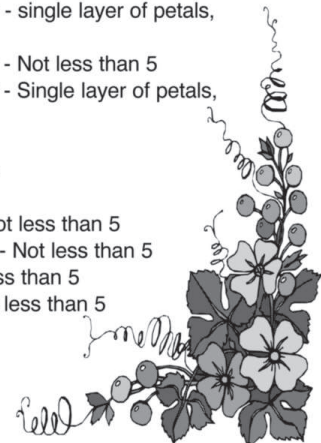
