- Only one entry accepted in each class from any one exhibitor. ONLY ONE VARIETY OF FLOWER CAN BE ENTERED IN ANY ONE CLASS. ANY DUPLICATE ENTRIES WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.
- When using your own containers, be sure to place a red sticker (provided) on front of entry tag. A limited number of containers are available for your use.
- The Supervisor shall have the right to remove at any time any exhibits or parts thereof which are unsightly.
- Exhibits will be released on Sunday, after the Fair, between 10:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. If absolutely necessary some exhibits may be picked up after 9:00 p.m. Saturday. Security will be provided Saturday evening. The E.I.S.F. will not be responsible for exhibits left after Sunday at 3:00 p.m.


