### **AWARDS SOCIAL & CEREMONY**

Thursday, August 29, 2019, from 7:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m.

Awards Ceremony will be at 7:30 p.m.

Light refreshments will be served.

Each artist may bring one guest to the Awards Ceremony.

#### **ENTRY FEES:**

#### DIVISION I – PROFESSIONAL

- There is a limit of three works per exhibitor, two of which may be 40" or larger on longest dimension.
- \$10.00 per item Less than 40" at the longest point (not including frame)
- \$25.00 per item 40" or greater at the longest point (not including frame)

#### • DIVISION II – AMATEUR

- There is a limit of three works per exhibitor, two of which may be 40" or larger on longest dimension.
- \$6.00 per item Less than 40" at the longest point (not including frame)
- \$15.00 per item 40" or greater at the longest point (not including frame)

#### • DIVISION III – YOUTH

• \$2.00 per item – up to 3 items per exhibitor

#### **RELEASE DATE: (NO EXCEPTIONS)**

- Sunday, September 8, 2019 from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
- Monday, September 9, 2019 from 8:30 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

The Fair will not be responsible for articles left after 7:00 p.m. on Monday, September 9, 2019. There will be a Storage Fee on ALL entries left after the 3rd week of September. The charge will be \$20.00 per week per item.

**CASH PREMIUMS:** will be available on Park Street-Payout Window (west of the main gate)

- Monday Saturday, September 2 7, 2019 from 10:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.
- Sunday, September 8, 2019 from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
- Monday, September 9, 2019 from 8:30 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.
- After September 10, 2019 awards will be given out only during regular office hours and may be picked up at the E.I.S.F. Main Office, hours are 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. with lunch from 12:00 p.m. to 1:00 p.m. E.I.S.F. Main Office will also be closed on September 13, 2019 at 3:00 p.m. and will be closed on September 16, 2019 all day to observe Labor Day Holiday for employees. Premiums not claimed by September 30, 2019 will be considered a donation and will revert back to the Fair's general fund.

### **SPECIAL DEPARTMENT RULES:**

- A. All articles shall be under the control of the Superintendents of this department. Every precaution will be taken to insure the safety of the exhibits, but the artist assumes all responsibility in case of loss or theft and in no case will the Management of the Eastern Idaho State Fair or the Superintendent's be responsible for loss or damage. Exhibitors are requested to read the General Rules and Regulations of this fair.
- B. Submission of art work in the Fine Arts Department signifies acceptance of such rules.
- C. Superintendent's reserves the right to reject any objectionable or inappropriate artwork.
- D. Superintendent's has the authority to divide or combine categories if needed.
- E. Exhibitor may put a 2" x 3" business card with your name and contact information may be displayed with entry. *However, no prices may be listed.*

- F. NO PREMIUM WILL BE PAID IF NO COMPETITION EXISTS A COMPETITION CONSISTS OF A MINIMUM OF FOUR (4) OR MORE ENTRIES IN A SINGLE DEPARTMENT CLASS.
- G. Superintendent has the right to move an entry into a different class if the original entered class will not have enough entries for a competition to exist.
- H. Superintendent will be the only person authorized to change class entries.
- I. Awards will be made according to the merits of the entry. If the judge decides an entry is not worthy of 1<sup>st</sup> place, the judge may <u>disqualify</u> the entry or the judge can choose to award 2<sup>nd</sup> place, 3<sup>rd</sup> place, or 4<sup>th</sup> place premiums, this is at the judge's discretion.
- J. If there is no competition for an entry, but the judge still deems that the entry would have been worthy of a blue ribbon it can be still be considered for any Department Special Awards.
- K. Only one of each placing in any one class will be awarded, unless otherwise specified in Department Special Rules.
- L. ADDITIONAL INSTRUCTIONS: See "EASTERN IDAHO STATE FAIR 2019 GENERAL RULES"

#### **FINE ART GUIDELINES:**

- A. All Artwork in Division I and II will be professional in presentation, including a screwed-in wire hanger. No sawtooth hangers will be accepted.
- B. DIVISION I PROFESSIONAL Each entry must be the submitting artist's original work (concept and execution). NO previously entered artwork will be allowed.
- C. DIVISION II AMATUER All wishing to enter the exhibition are welcome in this class. Artwork done in classroom or workshop settings may be included. All artwork must have been created in the last three years and never entered before in the Eastern Idaho State Fair.
- D. DIVISION III YOUTH Done on paper must be mounted on a board or construction paper. Mating or framing is encouraged. Velcro may be used as the hanging device if the work is unframed and lightweight, otherwise a wire hanger must be used- anchored with screws. Please do not use tape as a hanging device.
