- * NO TRAILER PARKING IN P4-GODDARD PARKING LOT or P5-LIGHT HORSE PARKING LOT, LOAD AND UNLOAD ONLY. Parking available on Jones Street and north of Horse Racing Barn--South of P6-BOOSTER PARKING LOT, for trailers.
- * ALL EXHIBITORS MUST BE IN BARN UNTIL RELEASE TIMES.
- * NO BLUE OR COLORED TARPS MAY BE HUNG UP ON OR IN BARNS.
- * BARN AREA, INCLUDING GROOMING CHUTE AREA, MUST BE CLEAN AND NEAT AT ALL TIMES.
- * NO ONE IS ALLOWED TO STAY OVERNIGHT IN BARNS, even in Grooming Chute Area.

ARRIVAL DATE: Boer goats must enter between 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. (noon) on Wednesday, September 6, 2023.

RELEASE DATE: Boer Goats will be released <u>after</u> 4:00 p.m. Saturday, September 9, 2023.

STALLS:

- The Superintendent will assign stalls. <u>ALL ANIMALS STALLED MUST BE SHOWN.</u>
- Stall request is on Entry Form, no charge for stalls.
- Initial bedding will be provided by EISF on entry date.
- All stalled animals must stay for the entire ½ week of their specific division.
- Stalls must be cleaned by 8:00 a.m. each day and refuse disposed of as the Superintendent may direct.
- Stalls must be cleaned prior to leaving on release dates.

SPECIAL DEPARTMENT RULES:

- All Boer goats to be shown must be registered ABGA, except Commercial Meat Goats.
- All Boer goats entered or stalled in the barn must be shown.
- The base date for computing age of the animal shall be September 1, 2023.
- Pens must be cleaned by 8:00 a.m. each day and refuse disposed of as the superintendent may direct.
- Trucks and trailers cannot be parked in the vicinity of the livestock exhibit building, but must be parked in space designated by the superintendent.
- All cars, trucks and trailers must be out of the barn area by 10:00 a.m. each day of the fair.
- All Boer goat exhibitors must comply with all general rules and regulations of the Eastern Idaho State Fair as listed in the exhibitor handbook.
- Commercial Meat Goats, MUST be individually identified, have Federal Scrapie Tag.
