- * **LIVESTOCK OFFICE HOURS HAVE CHANGED, please see "Livestock Office" below.**
- * **NO LIVESTOCK TRAILER PARKING IN P5-LIGHT HORSE PARKING LOT or P4-GODDARD PARKING LOT, 15 MINUTE LOAD AND UNLOAD ONLY.** Parking available on Jones Street, north side of Wooton Way, and south of P6-Booster Parking Lot, for livestock trailers. (See map)
- * **NO EARLY RELEASE OF ANIMALS.** Barns must stay full for Fairgoers to view.
- * **NO BLUE OR COLORED TARPS MAY BE HUNG UP IN BARN.**
- * **BARN AREA, INCLUDING GROOMING CHUTE AREA, MUST BE CLEAN AND NEAT AT ALL TIMES.**
- * **NO ONE IS ALLOWED TO STAY OVERNIGHT IN BARN, EVEN IN GROOMING CHUTE AREA.**

SPECIAL DEPARTMENT RULES:

1. Owner can only have one entry in each class
2. Braided, Mules, and Intermediate classes will be stalled Thursday evening/Friday morning through

Monday evening/Tuesday morning. Unbraided Horses will be stalled Tuesday afternoon through Saturday and released Saturday afternoon.

3. Horses can only be shown in EITHER Braided or Unbraided Classes, NO cross entering.
4. Due to the amount of interest, we have had with Exhibitors wanting to come to the Eastern Idaho State Fair, we can no longer pay for you to stay the entire week.
5. In Team class the judge will allow 25% match, 25% horsemanship and performance, 25% draftiness, 25% action and manner of move.
6. In the Unicorn hitch, 4-in-hand, and 6-in-hand, judges will allow 25% draftiness, 25% matching, 50% for performance and horsemanship.
7. Four and Six-in-hand constitutes 1 driver with that many horses in his hands.
8. Horses must be driven in a suitable wagon and harness.
9. The judge has the option to dismiss any unmanageable horses or hitches.
10. Classes may be switched at the discretion of the Superintendent.
11. Reasonable efforts are made to help participants get to the gate for each class. A three-minute gate hold will be announced if a participant is not at the gate. If a participant does not appear at the gate within three minutes, the class will be closed, and the participant will forfeit the class. Gate holds will be given at the discretion of the superintendent, judge, and/or ring steward.
12. If you have won the Amateur 4 Class in the past year, you cannot compete in the class.
13. Hitch premiums will be paid to the hitch (entry number) and will be determined by the number of horses brought to the show as completed on the entry form. This will apply to 1-2, 4, or 6 animals. **A horse may only be listed on (1) one entry form.**
14. If you have indicated you are bringing 4 horses on your entry form but would like to borrow 2 horses to enter other classes, you may do so but will not receive additional premiums. **You will only compete for awards given for classes you have entered.**
15. If you have indicated that you are bringing a pair of horses on your entry form but would like to loan them to another exhibitor to enter the 4 in hand classes, you may do so but will not receive additional payments. **You will only compete for awards given for the classes you have entered.**
16. Owner will only be paid for one (1) entry in each class.
17. Semi-Trucks & Trailers CANNOT BE PARKED in the vicinity of the livestock buildings used for loading and unloading only. Semi-Trucks and Trailers are permitted to park in the designated area located on Royal Street, west of Northwest Gate #6. (See map). All vehicles, trucks, and trailers must be out of the barn area by 10:00 a.m. each day of the fair.
18. **ADDITIONAL INSTRUCTIONS:** See "Eastern Idaho State Fair 2023 General Rules."
19. See "**ATV POLICY**" in "Eastern Idaho State Fair 2023 General Rules" for permit, insurance, and fee requirements. (NO ATV's ON FAIRGROUNDS WITHOUT PERMIT)
20. Signs advertising animals for sale are not permitted.
21. Youth Braided & Intermediate classes may be combined by Superintendent.
22. **The use of straw is prohibited in the Draft Horse Barn. Wood shavings will be available.**

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS:

1. All out-of-state entries must be accompanied by a Health Certificate. Out-of-state horses must have a health certificate and a negative Coggin's test within the last 6 months. A copy of current Health Certificate must be provided to Livestock Office upon entry to the fairgrounds.
2. ****Any livestock (equine, bovine, porcine, caprine, ovine, or cervidae) entering Idaho from a premises where vesicular stomatitis has been diagnosed within the last thirty (30) days shall be accompanied by a certificate of veterinary inspection dated within fourteen (14) days of entry containing the following statement: "All animals identified on this certificate of veterinary inspection have been examined and found to be free from Vesicular Stomatitis. During the last thirty (30) days, these animals have neither been exposed to VS nor located within an area where VS has been diagnosed."**
3. Vaccinate all horses coming to the EISF against the Equine Herpes Virus (Rhino). It comes in a 2-

way vaccine that is inexpensive and effective. Pneumabort K is one example that has proven to help prevent the neurological form. The vaccine does not provide 100% immunity but will provide a degree of protection from the virus.

4. Due to the risk of spreading equine-related diseases, the temperature of all horses **MUST** be taken twice (2) daily beginning three (3) days prior to entering the fairgrounds. If a horse has an elevated temperature of 101.5 degrees or greater, a veterinarian should be contacted before bringing the horse to the Fair.

STALLS:

1. Previous year exhibitors have priority on keeping their assigned stalls, barring unforeseen circumstances. An exhibitor will continue to have the choice to keep the assigned stalls as long as he/she exhibits at the fair.
2. Two horses per stall unless otherwise approved by the superintendent. All animals stalled must be shown and all animals shown have to be stalled for Jr. Draft Showmanship Competition. No loose horses allowed in the show arena.
3. Stalls must be cleaned by 8:00 a.m. each day, 4 (four) inch maximum of shavings per stall, all stalls must be stripped each day and refuse disposed of where the superintendent directs.
4. The Superintendent will determine assigned time each day that they will be available at Shaving Shed for exhibitors to obtain new shavings. Shaving Shed will be locked at all other times.
5. Stalls must be cleaned prior to leaving on release dates.

- E. No age limits on horses.
- F. Each participants must be displayed on back during competition.
- G. Judge may allow points for personal appearance of exhibitor. It would be advisable for all exhibitors to have a clean and neat appearance when showing animals.
 - 40 % for SHOWMANSHIP
 - 40 % for GROOMING
 - 20 % for HORSE
- H. Due to safety concerns, NO STALLIONS over a yearling will be allowed.
- I. All decisions by the Superintendent and Judge are final.
- J. Judge has option to dismiss any unmanageable or unruly horse.
- K. All “DRAFT HORSE HEALTH REQUIREMENTS” must be followed.
- L. All “DRAFT HORSE SPECIAL DEPARTMENT RULES” must be followed.
