## SPECIAL DEPARTMENT RULES:

A. Antiques must be 70 years old or older, unless specified in division headings.
B. Exhibits will be entered in the appropriate division and class ONLY.
C. Each individual exhibitor must be present during entering unless written approval from the Superintendent is received prior to entry dates.
D. NO ITEM LARGER THAN 2' X 3' FLOOR SPACE ACCEPTED.
E. Only department personnel will be allowed inside the railing.
F. Security will be on duty during entry and throughout the week of the fair.
G. Dishes MUST be washed, and other articles cleaned. Other small items must be in small boxes and secured.
H. No damaged or chipped articles will be accepted. EXCEPTIONS AT SUPERINTENDENTS' DISCRETION.
I. THE CHAMPION AWARD AND SUPERINTENDENT AWARD ITEMS CANNOT BE RE-ENTERED OR RECEIVE A RIBBON FOR 10 YEARS.
J. THE GRAND CHAMPION ITEM CANNOT BE RE-ENTERED OR RECEIVE A RIBBON FOR 15 YEARS.
K. Collections will consist of 6 (six) items only, SOME EXCEPTIONS MAY APPLY. Items must be of the same function, not matching and well displayed.
L. The Eastern Idaho Fair District will take reasonable precautions to ensure the safety of exhibits entered. However, the owners themselves must take the risk of exhibiting the articles. In no case will the Eastern Idaho Fair District be responsible in any way for loss or damage to articles submitted.
M. EXHIBITORS MUST IN ALL CASES BE THE BONA FIDE OWNERS OF ARTICLES EXHIBITED BY THEM. THE PERSON ENTERING THE ARTICLES FOR EXHIBIT IS RESPONSIBLE FOR THEM, AND MUST BE THE PERSON WHO PICKS THEM UP. PLEASE DO NOT ENTER FAMILY HEIRLOOMS. In no case will the Eastern Idaho Fair District be responsible in any way for loss or damage to articles submitted.
N. Presentation of article to be entered and submission of entry form shall be deemed acceptance of this rule.

0 . Judging will be based upon the following criteria: age, condition, rarity, overall appearance, and cleanliness. Acceptance of items for judging will be at the discretion of the judges, and/or superintendents.
P. TWO EXHIBITS ENTERED BY THE SAME PERSON OR HOUSEHOLD DOES NOT CONSTITUTE COMPETITION IN THE SAME CATEGORY AND/OR DIVISION AND WILL NOT BE JUDGED.
Q. No entry will be accepted unless a category for it is listed in the Exhibitor Handbook.
R. NO PREMIUM WILL BE PAID IF NO COMPETITION EXISTS - A COMPETITION CONSISTS OF A MINIMUM OF THREE (3) OR MORE ENTRIES IN A SINGLE DEPARTMENT CLASS.
S. Superintendents have the right to move an entry into a different class if the original entered class will not have enough entries for a competition to exist.
T. Superintendents will be the only persons authorized to change class entries.
U. Awards will be made according to the merits of the entry. If the judge decides an entry is not worthy of $1^{\text {st }}$ place, the judge may disqualify the entry or the judge can choose to award $2^{\text {nd }}$ place, or $3^{\text {rd }}$ place premiums, this is at the judge's discretion. If there is no competition for an entry, but the judge still deems that the entry would have been worthy of a blue ribbon it can still be considered for any Department Special Awards.
V. Only one of each placing in any one class will be awarded, unless otherwise specified in Department Special Rules.
