APPLICANT ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible to apply for this scholarship, an applicant must meet the following criteria:

NEW!!! 4H and/or FFA participation THREE OF THE LAST FIVE YEARS at Eastern
Idaho State Fair
Must have been a member in good standing of either 4-H and/or FFA as of
September 1, 2023
Be a 2024 graduating high school senior
Reside and go to school in the 16 County Eastern Idaho Fair District
Meet minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA requirements
Have taken <u>either</u> the ACT or SAT college entrance exam
Include college/university/vocational technical enrollment plans

ACTIVITIES:

The applicant's leadership potential and character should be demonstrated through the applicant's responses to the application categories detailing school, extracurricular, and community activities and achievements.

4-H OR FFA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENT:

The applicant must have been a member in good standing of either the Idaho 4-H Association or FFA Association at the time of the 2023 Eastern Idaho State Fair.

- Membership must be verified either by their 4-H Leader or FFA Advisor
- Signature of verification from 4-H or FFA Leader

ACADEMIC STANDING:

The applicant must be a 2024 graduating high school senior with a cumulative 2.5 grade point average.

The applicant's academic average will be reported on the application and verified on the submitted certified transcript.

COLLEGE/VOCATIONAL TECHNICAL SCHOOL ADMISSION:

An application will not be accepted without test scores. The applicant must have taken either the SAT or ACT college entrance examination before submission of the application.

Proof of the score may be a part of the official school transcript or a copy of the official test results and should be attached to the application. The information should reflect the date the test was taken.

NARRATIVE OR ESSAY:

Each applicant must include a typed narrative or essay of at least 350 words and a maximum of 500 words, double-spaced. In this narrative/essay, the applicant may supply any information that he/she feels is pertinent, how this scholarship would benefit the applicant's financial need or special circumstances, and indicate the importance of a college/university/vocational education in meeting long-term career goals.

The applicant's name and address must be typed as a heading to the narrative/essay in the upper right-hand corner of page one. Please attach this narrative/essay to the application.

REFERENCE (TWO):

Each applicant must attach **two (2) signed** letters of reference to your application.

- o One (1) from a school representative (teacher, counselor, principal)
- One (1) from someone other than a school representative or immediate family member

References may either be typed or handwritten and should include the name, address, and daytime phone number of the person making the recommendation, as well as an indication of the person's relationship to the applicant. Please attach these letters to the application.

EVALUATION PROCEDURE:

To evaluate applicants, the Eastern Idaho State Fair Board has appointed a Scholarship Selection Committee to review all completed applications. This committee will make final approval and notification of each scholarship recipient. Depending on the number of applications received, a personal interview may be held with the committee. Scholarship recipients will be recognized during the EISF Board Meeting in April 2024.
