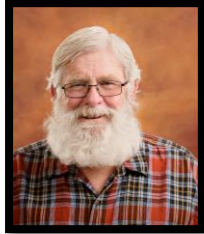

REMINDERS FOR 2024

- * **ALL EXHIBITS MUST BE IN THE BARN UNTIL RELEASE TIMES.**
- * **NO BLUE OR COLORED TARPS MAY BE HUNG ON OR IN BARNs.**
- * **BARN AREA, INCLUDING GROOMING CHUTE AREA, MUST BE CLEAN AND NEAT AT ALL TIMES.**
- * **NO ONE IS ALLOWED TO STAY OVERNIGHT IN BARNs, even in the Grooming Chute Area.**
- * **NO DOGS or OTHER ANIMALS THAT ARE NOT ENTRIES AT OUR FAIR ARE ALLOWED ON EISF PROPERTY, except Fully Trained Service Animals.** (full information available on EISF Website or <https://www.ADA.gov>)
- * **NO DOGS OR ANY OTHER ANIMALS ARE ALLOWED IN LIVESTOCK BARNs, including Service Animals, per ADA Guidelines.** (full information available on EISF Website or <https://www.ADA.gov>)

- Poultry will be released at 4:00 p.m. on Saturday, September 7, 2024.
- There will be no early release and late entries will be accepted at the discretion of the Superintendent.

PENS: Will be assigned by Superintendent.

CASH PREMIUMS: will be available at Park Street-Payout Window, west of Main Gate No. 1.

THE SHOW WILL INCLUDE DUCKS, GEESE AND TURKEYS.**

ENTRY INFORMATION:

- A. All birds will be judged by the APA and ABA Standards of Perfection.
- B. Birds shown by a Junior must be identified. Any birds not noted will be judged with adult exhibitors. INCLUDE DIVISION, CLASS, VARIETY (COLOR) AND GENDER/SEX (PULLET, COCKEREL, HEN, COCK), WITH EACH AND EVERY BIRD.
- C. Include exhibitor's phone number on all entry forms. If this information is incomplete or inaccurate, the exhibitor will be called for the information. Please be thorough when completing the entry form.
- D. **All birds shown must have numbered leg band and entry form must include band number for each bird.** Exhibitors must find their own bands. Check the internet at www.jeds.com or call 1-800-659-5928; you may also call Firth Mill (208) 346-6122.
- E. There will be a class for each breed entered.
- F. Birds over 1 year old will be classified as Cocks and Hens; birds under 1 year old as Cockerels and Pullets.
- G. Entries must state whether entries are large fowl, bantams, ducks, geese, or turkeys, whether non-bearded or bearded, and whether single or rose comb.
- H. Birds are entered at owner's risk. The Fair will not be responsible for the birds during the show. However, every precaution will be taken to ensure their safety.

JUDGING:

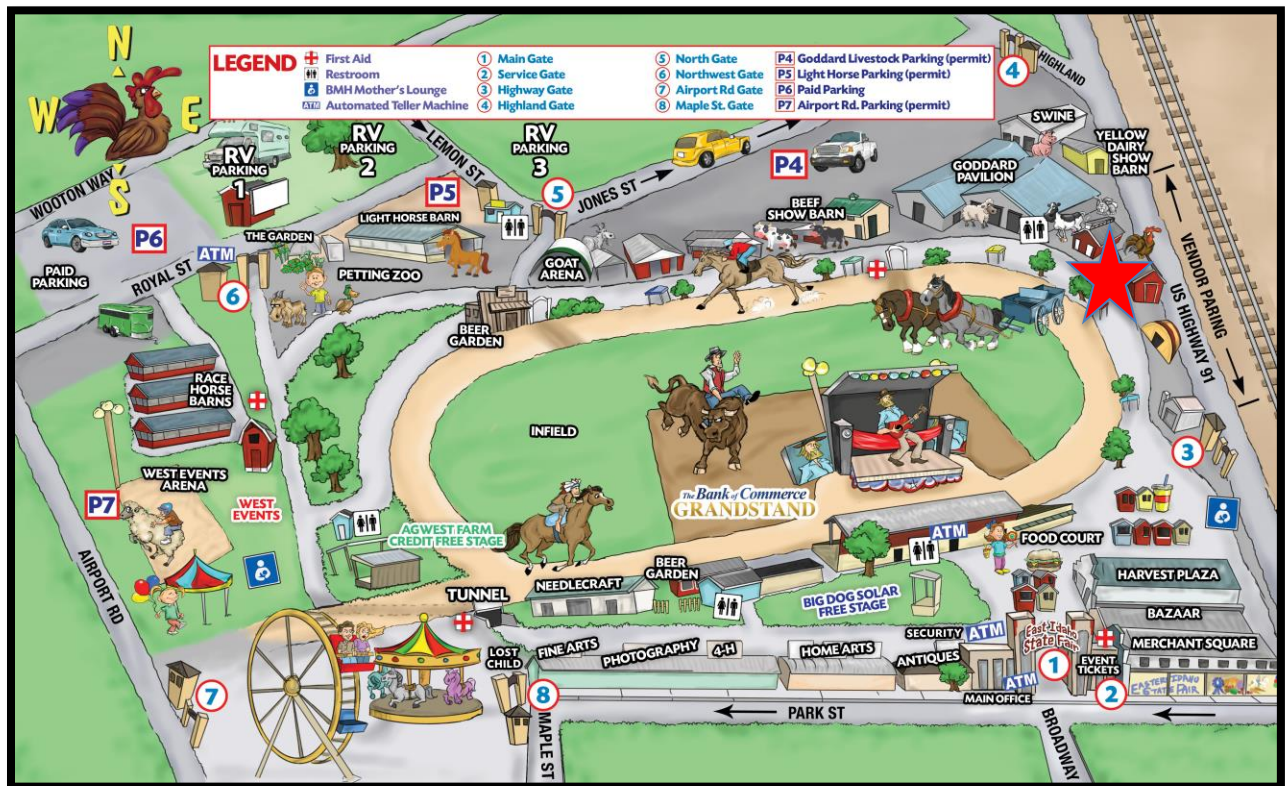
- A. Judging will be in the Red Poultry Barn at 9:00 a.m. on Monday, September 2, 2024. Judging for the Junior Division will be first with the Senior Division to follow. Junior Divisions will compete against all other Junior Divisions.
- B. In the Junior Division, the bird must be raised by the Junior Exhibitor.
- C. The right is reserved for the judge to disqualify all unworthy entries. Each entry must be the property of the exhibitor and must be shown in its natural condition. The judge's decision is final.

SPECIAL DEPARTMENT RULES:

- A. No one will be allowed to handle the birds except the judge, on-site vet, show committee, or its owner. All birds must be put into cages by owner for liability reasons.
- B. Signs placed in cages advertising animals for sale is prohibited. Business cards may be placed in or on the cages.
- C. **ADDITIONAL INSTRUCTIONS: See “EASTERN IDAHO STATE FAIR 2024 GENERAL RULES”**
- D. See “ATV POLICY” in “Eastern Idaho State Fair 2024 General Rules” for permit and fees. (NO ATV’s ON FAIRGROUNDS WITHOUT PERMIT)

HEALTH REGULATIONS:

- A. Any bird showing signs of ill health will be removed from the show. Exhibitors **MUST** dust poultry for lice and mites one week before the show. No bird may be entered that has leg mites, C.R.D., or any other health problem.
- B. Any bird showing evidence of disease will be placed in isolation and returned to its owner.
