GENERAL RULES

- 1. Be creative, cream cheese MUST be used in recipe and shall consist of a ½ cup or more.
- 2. Any age welcome to enter. Only one (1) entry per person allowed.
- 3. The contest is intended for amateur bakers only. Professional bakers or those who earn a significant portion of their livelihood from baking may not enter.
- 4. All entries must be accompanied with the typewritten recipe. Every ingredient must be listed in exact measurements and the type of ingredient must be specified, all preparation steps, temperature and cooking time must be specified.
- 5. Contestants submitting entries under another's name will be disqualified.
- 6. Each recipe for the "Reed's Dairy Baking Contest Cream Cheese" must be and original creation developed by the contestant(s) and should not be entered in any other competitions (example: "Best of Show") at the 2024 Eastern Idaho State Fair.
- 7. The cream cheese creation must be made from scratch (no mixes allowed) a minimum of 8 (eight) cookies/bars; 1 layer cake, etc. must be submitted for judging.
- 8. The fair's general rules and contest policies will apply when there is a question about a rule, see "2024 Eastern Idaho State Fair General Rules". However, in the event of a tie, only one 1st Place winner can be chosen.
- 9. All recipes become the property of Reed's Dairy and the Eastern Idaho State Fair and may be edited, adapted, copyrighted, published and used by them for publicity, promotion and advertising at their discretion without compensation to the contestant.
- 10. Winner's MUST be present to win.
- 11. Plate and decorations are allowed. The Fair is not responsible for the return of the plates.
- 12. Decisions are the sole responsibility of the Fair Judge and are final.
- 13. Items will be judged on the following: Flavor-30 points, Texture-30 points, Originality-15 points, Ease of Preparation-15 points, Appearance-10 points = 100 points.
