RULES:

1-All contestants must be at least 18 years old.

2-All contestants must pre-register by Thursday, August 28, 2025. Entry fee is \$5.00 and must be paid with the entry form, prior to the contest.

3-On Friday, August 29, 2025, each contestant will receive an email from the Canning & Baking Superintendent with the rules for the contest, as well as a required response, to be used as a test for email accuracy. If no response is received, no email will be sent on Saturday. <u>If an email isn't received by</u> 6 p.m. on Friday, please call the Fair office @ 208-785-2480.

4-At 8:00 a.m. on Saturday, August 30, 2025, each contestant will be emailed a list of 2 ingredients that **must** be used in their entry. Entry can be an appetizer, main course or dessert; but both ingredients must be used \underline{in} the entry and not just used as a garnish, dip or side dish. Any other ingredients may be used as needed.

5-Entry will be made <u>AT HOME</u>, and then brought to the Home Arts Building-Demonstration Kitchen between 5:00-6:00 p.m. on Saturday, August 30, 2025, prior to being judged.

6-No mixes, or pre-made items may be used.

7-A typewritten copy of the recipe will be required upon entry, Exhibitor releases and authorizes EISF to print recipe in EISF Cookbook, with no compensation to Exhibitor.

8-Entries will be judged on the following:

- Use of ingredients
- Taste
- Creativity
- Presentation
