ENTRY INFORMATION: Entry Forms are available at www.funatthefair.com, select the EXHIBITORS & COMPETITORS button on the home page then scroll down to find your specific department. Please complete the Fine Arts Entry Form and bring with you on entering date along with your artwork. Or you may pick up an entry form at the time of entering.

ENTRY LOCATION: Eastern Idaho State Fair, Fine Art Department, 4-H Building (green building near Carnival Lot) 97 Park Street, Blackfoot, ID 83221. Contact EISF with any questions at 208-785-2480; or email entries@funatthefair.com.

ENTRY DATES:

- Friday, August 22, 2025, from 11:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.
- Saturday, August 23, 2025, from 11:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
 - No exhibits will be received after these hours.

ENTRY FORM/TAGS:

- Entry Forms are available online, please print and bring in with you on day of entering or Entry Forms will be available at time of entering.
- There will <u>NOT</u> be any entry tags given out prior to entry day.

ENTRY FEES:

Division A – PROFESSIONAL

- There is a limit of three (3) works per exhibitor, with a maximum of 36" on the longest dimension.
- \$10.00 per item Less than 40" at the longest point (including frame)
- \$25.00 per item 40" or greater at the longest point (including frame)

• Division B - AMATEUR

- There is a limit of three (3) works per exhibitor, two of which may be 40" or larger on longest dimension.
- \$6.00 per item Less than 40" at the longest point (including frame)
- \$15.00 per item 40" or greater at the longest point (including frame)

Division C – YOUTH

- There is a limit of three (3) works per exhibitor, one (1) of which may be 40" or larger on longest dimension.
- \$2.00 per item entered.

RELEASE DATES: (NO EXCEPTIONS)

- Sunday, September 7, 2025, from 10:00 a.m. 4:00 p.m.
- Monday, September 8, 2025, from 8:30 a.m. 7:00 p.m.
- The Fair will not be responsible for articles left after 7:00 p.m. on Monday, September 8, 2025. There will be a Storage Fee on ALL artwork left after September 9, 2025. The charge will be \$20.00 per week per item. All artwork not picked up will be disposed of 60 days after completion of Fair.

CASH PREMIUMS: will be available at Park Street-Payout Window, west of Main Gate No. 1.

- Monday, September 1 through Saturday, September 6, 2025, from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
- Sunday, September 7, 2025, from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
- Monday, September 8, 2025, from 8:30 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. at the Photography Dept. Bldg.
- After September 9, 2025, awards will be given out only during regular office hours and may be picked up at the E.I.S.F. Main Office, hours are 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. with lunch from 12:00 p.m. to 1:00 p.m. E.I.S.F. Main Office will also be closed on Friday, September 12, 2025, at 3:00 p.m. and will be closed on Monday, September 15, 2025, all day to observe the Labor Day Holiday for office employees. *Premiums not claimed by September 30, 2025, will be considered a donation, and will revert to the EISF General Fund.*

SPECIAL DEPARTMENT RULES:

- A. All articles shall be under the control of the Superintendents of this department. Every reasonable precaution will be taken to ensure the safety of the exhibits, but the artist assumes all responsibility in case of loss or theft and in no case will the Management of the Eastern Idaho State Fair or the Superintendent's be responsible for loss or damage. Exhibitors are requested to read the General Rules and Regulations of this fair.
- B. Submission of artwork in the Fine Arts Department signifies acceptance of such rules.
- C. Superintendent reserves the right to reject any objectionable or inappropriate artwork.
- D. Superintendent has the authority to divide or combine categories if needed.
- E. Exhibitor may put a business card with your name and contact information to be displayed with entry. *However, no prices may be listed.*
- F. NO PREMIUM WILL BE PAID IF NO COMPETITION EXISTS A COMPETITION CONSISTS OF A MINIMUM OF THREE (3) OR MORE ENTRIES IN A SINGLE DEPARTMENT CLASS.
- G. Superintendent has the right to move an entry into a different class if the original entered class will not have enough entries for a competition to exist.
- H. Superintendent will be the only person authorized to change class entries.

- I. Awards will be made according to the merits of the entry. If the judge decides an entry is not worthy of 1st place, the judge may <u>disqualify</u> the entry or the judge can choose to award 2nd place, 3rd place, or 4th place premiums, this is at the judge's discretion.
- J. If there is no competition for an entry, but the judge still deems that the entry would have been worthy of a blue ribbon it can still be considered for any Department Special Awards.
- K. No altered or modified photographs. Digital Art must be original creation of artist.
- L. Original art only, no prints or reproductions.
- M. ADDITIONAL INSTRUCTIONS: See "EASTERN IDAHO STATE FAIR 2025 GENERAL RULES"

FINE ART GUIDELINES:

- 1. <u>All Artwork in Division A and B will be professional in presentation, including a screwed-in wire hanger. No sawtooth hangers will be accepted.</u>
- 2. DIVISION A PROFESSIONAL Each entry must be the submitting artist's original work (concept and execution). NO previously entered artwork will be allowed.
- 3. DIVISION B AMATUER All wishing to enter the exhibition are welcome in this class. Artwork done in classroom or workshop settings may be included. All artworks must have been created in the last three years and never entered before in the Eastern Idaho State Fair.
- 4. DIVISION C YOUTH Artwork done on paper must be mounted on a board with hanger or construction paper. Matting or framing is encouraged. Velcro may be used, Velcro should be hook type (not loop) as the hanging device if the work is unframed and lightweight, otherwise a wire hanger must be used- anchored with screws. Please do not use tape as a hanging device. Superintendents will be available to assist with hangers, but will not be held responsible for any damage to any exhibit that has a hanging failure at any time.
