- Friday, August 22, 2025, from 11:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.
- Saturday, August 23, 2025, from 11:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
 - No exhibits will be received after these hours.

ENTRY FEES:

• \$1.00 each for the first 4 items or \$5.00 per sheet

ENTRY LOCATION: E.I.S.F. Home Arts Building which is located two buildings down from Main Office – enter through west door, please park on the street or in the carnival lot area, not on the road in front of the building.

ENTRY FORM/TAGS:

- Entry Forms are available online, please complete Hobbies & Crafts Entry Form and bring with you on the entering date or entry forms will also be available on entering date for you to complete.
- There will <u>NOT</u> be any entry tags given out prior to entry day.
- Entry tags will be printed during the entry process.

RELEASE DATE:

- Sunday, September 7, 2025, from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. (NO EXCEPTIONS)
 - The Fair will not be responsible for articles left after 4:00 p.m. on Sunday, September 7, 2025.
 - <u>ALL ENTRIES</u> not picked up will be disposed of 30 days after completion of Fair.

CASH PREMIUMS: will be available at Park Street-Payout Window, west of Main Gate No. 1.

- Monday, September 1 through Saturday, September 6, 2025, from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
- Sunday, September 7, 2025, from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
- Monday, September 8, 2025, from 8:30 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. *at the Photography Dept. Bldg.*
- After September 9, 2025, awards will be given out only during regular office hours and may be picked up at the E.I.S.F. Main Office, hours are 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. with lunch from 12:00 p.m. to 1:00 p.m. E.I.S.F. Main Office will also be closed on Friday, September 12, 2025, at 3:00 p.m. and will be closed on Monday, September 15, 2025, all day to observe the Labor Day Holiday for office employees. *Premiums not claimed by September 30, 2025, will be considered a donation, and will revert to the EISF General Fund.*


SPECIAL DEPARTMENT RULES:

- A. USE A PENCIL TO FILL IN YOUR EXHIBITOR FORM, NO INK PENS, PLEASE.
- B. Items must be made between September 2024 and August 2025. Any item that does not meet this qualification will not be judged. No item can be entered for competitions made before September 2024.
- C. No entry will be accepted unless a category exists and is listed in the online premium fair book.
- D. Exhibitors may not enter more than 1 (one) item per Class.
- E. No items with any kind of food or candy will be accepted.
- F. All items must be ready to display ie: Framed *or* ready to hang or mounted securely on a piece of foam-core. No cardboard *or* cardstock allowed.
- G. Judging is done according to the merits of the entry. Only one of each 1st, 2nd and 3rd place ribbons is awarded per class. Honorable Mentions as per the Judge.
- H. The Superintendent reserves the right to move an entry into a different Class if the original entered Class will not have enough entries for a competition to exist.
- I. The Eastern Idaho State Fair will NOT be responsible in any way for the security of entries. BUT precautions will be taken to protect against breakage, theft, or damage of any kind.
- J. Two exhibits entered by the same person <u>or household</u> does not constitute competition in the same category and/or division and will <u>not</u> be judged.
- K. <u>NO PREMIUM WILL BE PAID IF NO COMPETITION EXISTS</u> A COMPETITION CONSISTS OF A MINIMUM OF THREE (3) OR MORE ENTRIES IN A SINGLE DEPARTMENT CLASS.

- L. Awards will be made according to the merits of the entry. If the judge decides an entry is not worthy of 1st place, the judge may <u>disqualify</u> the entry or the judge can choose to award 2nd place, or 3rd place premiums, this is at the judge's discretion.
- M. If there is no competition for an entry, but the judge still deems that the entry would have been worthy of a blue ribbon it can still be considered for any Department Special Awards.
- N. Only one of each placing in any one class will be awarded, unless otherwise specified in Department Special Rules.
- 0. The Superintendent reserves the right to limit the number of entries entered by an exhibitor.
- P. ADDITIONAL INSTRUCTIONS: See "EASTERN IDAHO STATE FAIR 2025 GENERAL RULES".


