ENTRY DEADLINE:

- September 3, 2026
- After September 3 you will only be allowed to register if there are timeslots available.

ENTRY & FEES:

1. \$30.00 entry fee
2. Pre-enter and pay fees to be in draw. We will have to limit entries to stay within our limited time frame.
3. Register to Enter at <https://letsrace.arenasoft.app/>
4. All competitions results will be kept current on the above website.

EXHIBITOR ENTRY/PASS:

1. All contestants to enter thru Gate No. 5 – North Gate and then cross track to enter Infield.
2. Trailer Parking will be on the West end of the Infield or as instructed by Superintendent and Security.

3. **Trailers MUST be removed by 1:00 pm NO EXCEPTIONS.** Gates will be locked and will not be unlocked until 11:00 pm, access to infield will not be granted during nighttime shows, starting at 4:00 pm daily.
4. No exhibitor passes. Contestant list will be at Gate No. 5, only registered contestants will be allowed in, all others will be required to pay the EISF gate entrance fee.
5. Check-in or pre-enter at designated area on the infield.

PURSE MONEY: \$200.00 added purse money

GENERAL RULES: See “2026 Eastern Idaho State Fair General Rules” for complete rules and regulations.

HEALTH POLICY:

- A. All out-of-state entries must be accompanied by a **current Health Certificate**. Out-of-state horses must have a health certificate and a negative Coggin’s test within the last 6 months. **Copy of current Health Certificate must be provided to Livestock Office upon entry to the fairgrounds.**
 - ****Any livestock (equine, bovine, porcine, caprine, ovine, or cervidae) entering Idaho from a premises where vesicular stomatitis has been diagnosed within the last thirty (30) days shall be accompanied by a certificate of veterinary inspection dated within fourteen (14) days of entry containing the following statement: “All animals identified on this certificate of veterinary inspection have been examined and found to be free from Vesicular Stomatitis. During the last thirty (30) days, these animals have neither been exposed to VS nor located within an area where VS has been diagnosed.”**
- B. Vaccinate all horses coming to the EISF against the Equine Herpes Virus (Rhino). It comes in a 2-way vaccine that is inexpensive and effective. Pneumabort K is one example that has proven to help prevent the neurological form. The vaccine does not provide 100% immunity but will provide a degree of protection from the virus.
- C. Due to the risk of spreading equine-related diseases, the temperature of all horses **MUST** be taken twice (2) daily beginning three (3) days prior to entering the fairgrounds. If a horse has an elevated temperature of 101.5 degrees or greater, a veterinarian should be contacted before bringing the horse to the Fair.
