REMINDERS FOR 2026

- * **NO TRAILER PARKING IN THE P4-GODDARD LOT. LOAD AND UNLOAD ONLY.**
- * **ALL LIVESTOCK/HORSES MUST REMAIN IN THE BARN UNTIL RELEASE TIMES.**
- * **NO BLUE OR COLORED TARPS MAY BE HUNG ON OR IN BARNS.**
- * **BARN AREA, INCLUDING GROOMING CHUTE AREA, MUST BE CLEAN AND NEAT AT ALL TIMES.**
- * **NO ONE IS ALLOWED TO STAY OVERNIGHT IN BARNS, even in the Grooming Chute Area.**
- * **NO DOGS or OTHER ANIMALS THAT ARE NOT ENTRIES AT THE FAIR ARE ALLOWED ON EISF PROPERTY, except Fully Trained Service Animals.** (full information available on EISF Website or <https://www.ADA.gov>)
- * **NO DOGS OR ANY OTHER ANIMALS ARE ALLOWED IN LIVESTOCK BARNS, including Service Animals, per ADA Guidelines.** (full information available on EISF Website or <https://www.ADA.gov>)

- Entry forms must list the name and registration number of each animal entered. A copy of the registration paper must accompany the entry form, except Commercial Meat Goats.

ENTRY FORM DUE DATE: Friday, August 21, 2026, by 5:00 p.m.

ENTRY FEE: \$5.00 will be charged per entry.

- Exhibitors may make as many entries in each class as desired, but no exhibitor will be allowed more than two premiums in any one class. **Limited space available.**

LATE FEE: \$10.00 will be charged after Friday, August 21, 2026.

- All substitute exhibits must be entered no later than 6:00 p.m., Tuesday, September 8, 2026.

PASSES:

- \$25.00 Exhibitor full week pass (1 pass allowed per exhibitor)
- \$15.00 Exhibitor ½ week pass (2 passes allowed per exhibitor)
 - Caretakers may also purchase exhibitor's tickets, but no more than one ticket will be allowed for each three (3) animals entered.

ARRIVAL DATE: Boer goats must enter between 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, September 8, 2026.

RELEASE DATE: Boer Goats will be released **after** 12:00 p.m. (noon) Thursday, September 10, 2026.

STALLS:

- The Superintendent will assign stalls. ALL ANIMALS STALLED MUST BE SHOWN.
- Stall request is on Entry Form, no charge for stalls.
- Initial bedding will be provided by EISF on entry date.
- Stalls must be cleaned by 8:00 a.m. each day and refuse disposed of as the Superintendent may direct.
- Stalls must be cleaned prior to leaving on release dates.

SPECIAL DEPARTMENT RULES:

- All Boer goats to be shown must be registered ABGA, except Commercial Meat Goats.
- All Boer goats entered or stalled in the barn must be shown.
- The base date for computing age of the animal shall be September 1, 2026.
- Pens must be cleaned by 8:00 a.m. each day and refuse disposed of as the superintendent may direct.
- Trucks and trailers cannot be parked in the vicinity of the livestock exhibit building, but must be parked in space designated by the superintendent.
- All cars, trucks and trailers must be out of the barn area by 10:00 a.m. each day of the fair.
- All Boer goat exhibitors must comply with all general rules and regulations of the Eastern Idaho State Fair as listed in the exhibitor handbook.
- Commercial Meat Goats, MUST be individually identified, have Federal Scrapie Tag.
- ADDITIONAL INSTRUCTIONS: See “EASTERN IDAHO STATE FAIR 2026 GENERAL RULES”
- See “ATV POLICY” in “Eastern Idaho State Fair 2026 General Rules” for permit and fees. (NO ATV’s ON FAIRGROUNDS WITHOUT PERMIT)

HEALTH RULES:

- All out of state Boer goats must have a health certificate and health permit number.
- All Boer goats will be health inspected upon entry to the Fair.
- Superintendent has the ability to send any animal home that appears ill or that the EISF veterinarian deems ill.
