- * **ALL ANIMALS MUST REMAIN IN THE BARN UNTIL THEIR RELEASE TIME.**
- * **NO BLUE OR COLORED TARPS MAY BE HUNG ON OR IN BARNS.**
- * **NO ONE IS ALLOWED TO STAY OVERNIGHT IN BARNS, even in the Grooming Chute Area.**
- * **NO DOGS or OTHER ANIMALS THAT ARE NOT ENTRIES AT THE FAIR ARE ALLOWED ON EISF PROPERTY, except Fully Trained Service Animals.** (full information available on EISF Website or <https://www.ADA.gov>)
- * **NO DOGS OR ANY OTHER ANIMALS ARE ALLOWED IN LIVESTOCK BARNS, including Service Animals, per ADA Guidelines.** (full information available on EISF Website or <https://www.ADA.gov>)

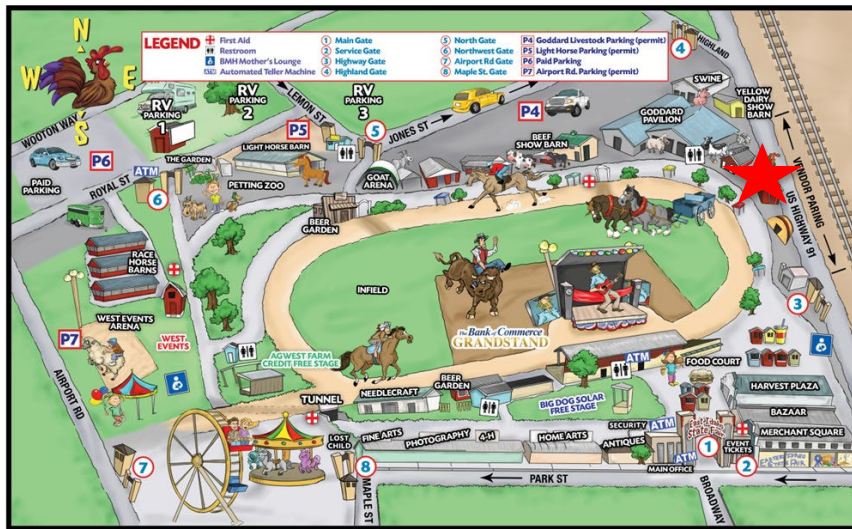

- All rabbits must be entered on Thursday, September 3, 2026, between 6:00 pm-9:00 pm
- All rabbits must be housed in the barn by 9:00 pm on Thursday, September 3, 2026.
- All exhibitors must be present by 8:30 am the morning of their show date.
- All rabbits must be housed in the barn for the entire week in order to be compete.



PENS: Will be assigned by Superintendent.

RELEASE DATE:

- Rabbits will be released on Saturday, September 12, 2026, at 6:00 pm
- In the event that the pens are full, early release will be at the discretion of the Superintendent.

CASH PREMIUMS: will be available at Park Street-Payout Window, west of Main Gate No. 1.

- Monday, September 7 through Saturday, September 12, 2026, from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
- Sunday, September 13, 2026, from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
- Monday, September 14, 2026, from 8:30 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. *in the Photography Dept. Bldg.*
- After September 15, 2026, premiums will be given out only during regular office hours and may be picked up at the EISF Main Office, hours are 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. with lunch from 12:00 p.m. to 1:00 p.m. EISF Main Office will also be closed on Friday, September 18, 2026, at 3:00 p.m. and will be closed on Monday, September 21, 2026, all day to observe the Labor Day Holiday for office employees. **Premiums not claimed by September 30, 2026, will be considered a donation, and will revert back to the EISF General Fund.**

SPECIAL DEPARTMENT RULES:

- All rabbits entered must have tattoo in left ear. Tattooing can be done at time of entry by local 4-H groups for \$3.50 per animal.
- Entry forms must list ear tattoo of animal entered, also the fair class number. A phone number and complete address of the exhibitor is also needed.
- Dogs will not be allowed in the rabbit barn, under any circumstances. NO EXCEPTIONS!!!**
- Rabbits under 12 weeks old will not be permitted in the barn. Does with litters will not be permitted. Any animal appearing to be underage will not be allowed in barn at Superintendents discretion without proof of age.
- All animals shall be property of exhibitor.
- ALL RABBITS MUST BE HEALTH CHECKED AND EXAMINED BY AUTHORIZED PERSONNEL BEFORE ENTERING BUILDING. ANY ANIMAL DEEMED UNWORTHY OF SHOW, OR THAT SHOWS SIGNS OF NEGLECT OR APPEAR TO BE UNHEALTHY WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO ENTER THE BARN AT THE SUPERINTENDENT'S DISCRETION. ALL ANIMALS TO BE EXHIBITED MUST ARRIVE IN APPROPRIATE TRANSPORT CARRIERS WITH ONE ANIMAL ONLY PER COMPARTMENT. CARDBOARD BOXES AND LIKE ENCLOSERS DO NOT ALLOW FOR PROPER VENTILATION AND ARE NOT APPROPRIATE. ANIMALS NOT IN APPROPRIATE TRANSPORT CARRIERS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED IN BARN. Appropriate carriers are available through online equipment dealers.
- All exhibitors must be present while animals are being judged, or the rabbits will NOT be judged, unless prior arrangements are made with the show officials for someone else to do it.
- All rabbits must be shown in natural condition; grooming that does not alter original state is permitted.
- No animal can be shown in both youth & adult classes.
- Signs placed in cages advertising animals for sale is prohibited. Business cards may be placed in or on the cages.
- All rabbits shown are to be purebred.**

- L. There will be no breeding of rabbits at this fair unless both owners' expressed permission is given and notification is given to the superintendent.
- M. Rabbits will be fed and watered by barn personnel unless requested otherwise. Please Note: Exhibitors must provide their own feed if they don't want the feed provided by the fair.
- N. All rabbits brought to the fair MUST pay an entry fee. Rabbits are not allowed to be sold or offered for sale outside of the barn.
- O. THE BEST IN SHOW, AND 1ST AND 2ND RUNNER-UP WINNERS MUST BE EXHIBITED UNTIL RELEASE TIME ON SATURDAY.
- P. **Any exhibitor taking their rabbits from the fairgrounds before the official release time, must have an early release form signed by the barn Superintendent, if not they WILL FORFEIT THEIR PREMIUMS AND AWARDS.**

- R. See "ATV POLICY" in "Eastern Idaho State Fair 2026 General Rules" for permit and fees. (NO ATV's ON FAIRGROUNDS WITHOUT PERMIT)

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS: General eliminations and disqualifications as follows: Animals found with snuffles, tumor, rupture, blindness in one or both eyes, lop ears except in lop-eared varieties, torn ears that noticeably detract from the appearance of the animal, off-colored or unmatched eyes, wolf or buck teeth, malocclusion or broken or missing teeth, crooked feet or legs, bowed legs, cow hocks, deformed bones, bucks not showing both testicles in normal condition, does heavy with young, sore hocks showing with infection, vent disease, abscesses, sore eyes, running eyes if severe or conspicuous, illegible permanent ear markings, permanent ear marking not in left ear, ear mites, mange, any respiratory illness.

DIVISION A — YOUTH CLASS

There are no Pre-Jr. or Intermediate Classes for the following breeds: FRENCH ANGORA, MINI LOP, NETHERLAND DWARF, HOLLAND LOP, TAN, REX, POLISH, HIMALAYAN. They must be shown as Junior or Senior.

REGULAR BREED CLASSES:

BREED FUR CLASSES:

- *All fur and wool classes to be separate paid entries, and all rabbits entered in fur and wool classes must be entered and shown in their respective classes. All fur entries, unless otherwise specified, will automatically be placed in the breed fur class. Substitutions in all fur and wool classes to be allowed within the same variety and breed.*

9. Breed Fur, white - only if breed has white variety
10. Breed Fur, all non-white colors for the breed (color not to be considered)
11. Fryer Fur

MEAT CLASSES:

Premium Classes 12-13: 1st place - \$4.00; 2nd place - \$3.00; 3rd place - \$2.00

12. Meat Pen - to consist of 3 fryers the same age & breed, not to be over 69 days of age, and weighing between 3 ½ - 5 ½ pounds.

13. Single Fryer - to consist of one fryer under 69 days

DIVISION B — ADULT CLASS

Premium Classes 20-27: 1st place - \$3.50; 2nd place - \$2.50; 3rd place - \$2.00
