**EXHIBITOR ENTRY/PARKING:**

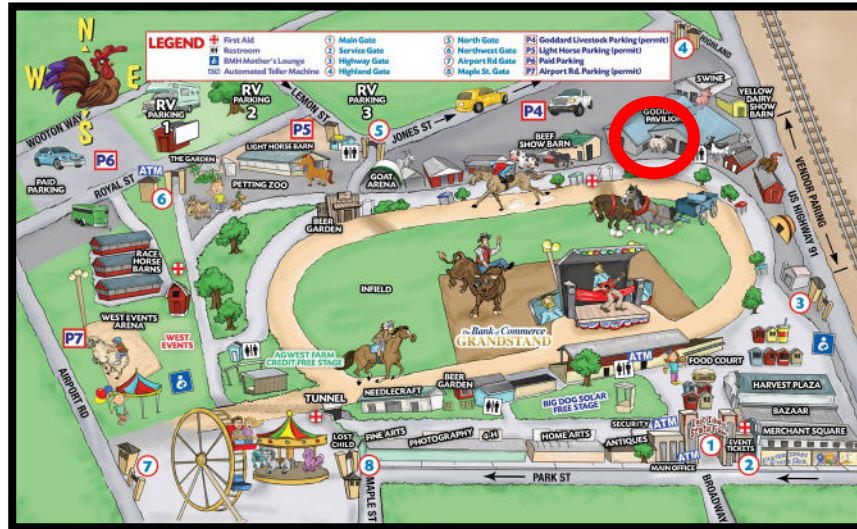
1. All contestants to enter thru Gate No. 4 – Highland Gate and park in the Goddard Livestock Parking lot.
2. Check-in at Livestock Office.

**SPECIAL DEPARTMENT RULES:**

- A. Fleeces must be delivered to the Goddard Pavillion between 9 am and no later than noon on Thursday, August 28, 2026. The Department Superintendent will give exhibitors an entry tag for each fleece. The card will include Exhibitors name, sheep breed and date sheared. These cards must be completed before the fleece will be accepted.
- B. The Eastern Idaho State Fair will NOT be responsible in any way for the security of entries. BUT precautions will be taken to protect against breakage, theft, or damage of any kind.

- C. Fleeces shall not be more than 12 months growth.
- D. All fleeces entered must have been sheared from sheep owned by the exhibitor.
- E. A fleece may only be entered in one class.
- F. Fleeces may be from either sex, excluding wethers.
- G. All fleeces must be skirted with bellies and tags out.
- H. Fleeces CANNOT be accepted if: They show insoluble paint. They show excessive dung tags, burns or dung, urine stains, and being cotted. If weak or broken. Superintendent may disqualify a fleece if they deem it unsuitable for competition. Clear bags will be provided by the fair for each fleece to be displayed in.
- I. After judging, some fleeces may be removed, so the better fleeces can be properly displayed.
- J. Judges' decisions are final. Judge may disqualify any entry for just cause and may reassign entries to categories as seem proper.
